I am glad to say that this platform is proving a ^{slight} bit useful for India. Pakistan delegate accused India of massacres etc. I gave a piece but telling ngl, stressing the need for understanding, give and take and keeping all issues open for discussion and settlement.

Today we have to discuss the need for ending international disparities. I have to speak for our delegation.

I am sorry to say that the I.P.U. people have cabled their inability to provide the air passage to Mrs. London (to Washington) and it costs Rs 500 or nearly £200/- so I am dropping that part of my plan. It is possible that I may be able to return to Delhi by the 6th Sept and be available for our meetings.

I got a few anxious enquiries from South Indian friends, before I left Delhi, wondering whether any ^{work} could not be done to save the Bihar debacle. They seem to have been impressed by Rampal's & ZETLA's complaint that they had been condemned without being heard. It seems Shri P.K. Ghosh has lined up with them.

Shri B.R. Reddiah, who agrees with us, suggests the convening of the C.C. also.
