My dear Masani

I found on my return to this place yesterday evening, a letter from Mr. NIKOLAJCZYK, President of the International Peasant Union (who had been the Prime Minister of Poland) inviting me to their 8th Congress to be held at WASHINGTON on the 4-6th September. He however said "at the moment. I write, I still do not know if we will be able to find your travel expenses. We are trying for round trip coach air fare and for a ten day stay. I repeat that if we get help, I will notify you immediately". His letter was dated the 28th July.

If they actually succeed in finding me the air-passage, I feel I ought to go to them, since they have been doing good work for World democracy and especially for the captive peoples of the Soviet Satellite Countries. This coincidence between the altogether unexpected invitation to COPENHAGEN and this invitation to WASHINGTON, both to materialise within a fortnight is so interesting.

If I have to go to WASHINGTON, then I cannot be available for our Programme meetings in Delhi between 6-9 September. So if you want me badly, then we have to postpone Delhi meetings till the 14th September. Otherwise, you have to carry on without me. The Party elections will anyhow have to be postponed till the 14th September.
