My dear Kripalani,

I have your letter of June 11
from Lucknow.

Both Masani and Ranga feel that
further public pursuit of your idea will
develop difficulties rather than bring the
objective nearer. What we should do, they

They feel that we may convert victories
achieved into defeat if we fail in these
attempts.

Will you kindly meet Masani and
Ranga as soon as possible before further
public canvassing? I am not publishing your
article (the one sent with your letter of
June 11) in view of what I have said. If you
will let me cut up the article, I can arrange
publication of your views without making it
appear that you are appealing for cooperation
from parties who seem to be standing off just now.
