1. The Hindustani Movement is completely non-political and is not going to take part in the elections.
2. Individual members are called upon to participate in the elections and are free to work and vote for any party or candidate they choose to do so.
3. The Hindustani Movement is starting a "Bahy-Hatao-Dal" in the country. The recruitment in the Dal is on the following conditions.
 - a. No member of the Dal will expect any remuneration in cash or kind from any political party or candidates. He will take a pledge to work for principles and not for material gain.
 - b. Every member of the Dal will take a pledge to give a certain fixed time during which he will work for the party and the candidate without fear.
 - c. Every member of the Dal will take a pledge to work with dignity and decorum and will not indulge in any violence. Any member of the Hindustani Movement can join the Dal after sending a written pledge on the above lines to the undersigned.
4. Any member who wishes to contest in the coming elections can do so, but he/and/or she will not be entitled to drag the name of the Hindustani Movement in this campaign, directly or indirectly by themselves or by their workers.

These are the broad guide-lines prepared for you by me so that you can use it in answering questions. I suggest you get this guide-lines published in the local papers. Please do write to me soon.
