I shall be extremely grateful to you if you will kindly consider my following appeal in connection with the observance of 'Gandhi Nirvan Din' on 30th January 1975.

As usual, on that day all political parties, social institutions and other organisations will separately hold prayers and meetings. We feel that beginning from coming 30th January, this day should be observed as "Shanti Din" and all political parties and other organisations should jointly conduct evening prayers on that day.

In these troubled times, when there is so much violence, suspicion and hatred all around us, it would be most appropriate that atleast on Gandhi Narvan Day, we should forget our differences of opinion, sink all suspicions and prejudices against each other and come together in silence to honour the memory of our beloved Bapu.

With this end in view, I invite you to participate in this prayer meeting which is organised by us on 30th January 1975 at 6.15 P.M. at Hutatma Chowk at Bombay.

The unique feature of this programme will be that there will not be any speeches, but only prayers. There will be tape recorded speeches of Mahatma Gandhi and others who worked and died for India's freedom.

I shall be most grateful to you if you will kindly accept this invitation of mine on behalf of the Hindustani Movement and participate in this prayer meeting.

I am looking forward to hearing your decision in the matter as early as possible.
