Lok Sabha.

Sir,

One of the members of my Party has given notice of the following resolution to be moved by him on Friday, March 6, during the discussion on non-official resolutions in which his name has been drawn on the ballot:

"This House is of opinion that the administration of all permits and licences in the mixed economy now in force should be entrusted with full autonomous authority to a non-party Board of economists and statesmen to function independently of Government."

Since the Secretariat appears to have some doubt as to whether this is precise enough and is not a little vague, I am dropping you this line to say that, in our view, the resolution is perfectly precise and clear and needs no amendment. If however it is felt that it should be a little more clear and precise than it is, we shall be quite prepared that the words "in the mixed economy now in force" may be replaced by the words "of an economic nature now issued by the Union Government or any of its ministries or departments."
