Sir,

We have drawn the first and second places respectively in the ballot for the resolution disapproving the Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Ordinance 1969.

Now that the Supreme Court is dealing with the petition which challenges not only the method of enactment of the Ordinance but also the entire issue of nationalisation of banking, the whole subject has become sub judice.

It is a tradition of this House that it has not so far discussed or legislated in regard to any matter which is sub judice.

Consistent with this tradition we request that our resolution should be brought up for discussion in the Lok Sabha after the Supreme Court has given its judgment in the matter.
