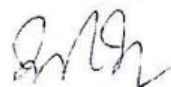
Sir,

I have received intimation by a communication of 18th November, 1967 from the Secretariat that the Minister of External Affairs has regretted inability to accept short notice of my short notice question No.55 regarding the nomination of the High Commissioner designate to the U.K.

I am bringing this matter to your notice as I feel that in a matter of this nature which if of some urgency, since the High Commissioner designate has not yet left this country and taken charge of his office, the Minister should not lightly decline to accept short notice when a senior member of the House and the Deputy Leader of the biggest Opposition Party makes the request.
