Subject: Allotment of office rooms to Parliamentary  
Parties/Groups in Parliament House.

Sir,

With reference to your letter dated the 22nd May, 1967, addressed to the Speaker, on the subject noted above, I am directed to state that the room in the lobby of the Central Hall was allotted to your Group during the last Parliament. The rooms of the same size and even smaller ones have been allotted to other Parties/Groups in the lobby of Central Hall/Library Hall Corridor. These rooms are meant for Party offices only and are not generally used for party meetings. As and when any Party/Group requires a room for their meeting, Committee rooms are always allotted to them even at short notice. This is the practice followed by all other Parties/Groups.

2. Room No. 19 referred to by you falls within the quota allotted to the Officers of the Lok Sabha Secretariat and is occupied by the Private Secretary to the Speaker.

3. As desired by Shri N.G. Ranga, the three stenographers are being shifted from the Members Lounge No. 2, Central Hall.
