My dear Raju,

Many thanks for your letter dated 7th November with enclosures. I have already contacted several people mentioned in your list. Mr.Sundaram also has written to some important individuals mentioned in your list. Mr.Sundaram would have, perhaps, sent a communication already to Mr.Girish Minshi suggesting that we call a meeting of the National Executive immediately at Bombay. Since the number of Executive committee members who are likely to attend this meeting may not exceed 7 or 8, I hope Mr.Minshi will not have any difficulty in agreeing to call a meeting of the National Executive at Bombay. Perhaps the meeting if held at Bombay will get a better press than from any other centre. You may also speak to Mr.Minshi over the 'phone and suggest that he may agree to the proposal and have the meeting at Bombay.

I am surprised to learn that Mr.Arya also might be in B L D by this time. I wrote to Mr.Arya as well as to Col.H.R.Pasricha but unfortunately both are keeping silent. Dr.Mathias is already in the BLD and hence we cannot count on him. The agenda suggested by you appears to be alright but we should pass a separate resolution in respect of the election symbol for communication to the Election Commission so that the mischief, if any, committed

by Mr. Piloo Mody may be neutralised.

As far as headquarters is concerned I personally feel that it would be better to continue the same in Bombay for several reasons. Any how this matter may be decided by the National Executive and the National General Council when these bodies meet.

I am glad to learn that BLD is not making any progress, even though Mr. Mody has succeeded in diverting contributions which are ^{legally} due to Swatantra to BLD. I believe if Mr. Masani really takes some interest at least in this matter, it would be possible to re-divert a major portion of the contributions to the Swatantra coffers.

I hope to write to you again shortly.

The Kerala State Council of the Swatantra Party met at 11 A.M. on 10th November, 1974 at Akkara Motors Building Hall, Kottayam under the presidentship of Mr. A.V. Varkey, Advocate and unanimously passed the following resolution:

This meeting of the State Council of the Swatantra Party notes with surprise that some Office Bearers of the Party claiming to represent the State Unit have decided unilaterally to merge with the B.L.D. This State Council, formally declares that such action taken by such Office Bearers are totally unwarranted, apart from being undemocratic.

The State Council of the Kerala Swatantra Party reiterates that the Party will continue in Kerala and hereby expels from membership of the Party M/S. K.T. Joseph, A.J. Dominic and Johnson J. Vallikappan for gross misuse of their official position they hold because of their election by this State Council.

The Kerala Swatantra Party is convinced that the so-called ~~national~~ alternative which the B.L.D. claims to be a misnomer and calculated to fool the people. It welcomes in this connection the decision of the Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu Units of the Party to keep the flag of the Party aloft.

The meeting elected a committee under the Convenorship of Mr. A.V. Varkey to guide and regulate the activities of the party till the next organisational elections and to take all legal measures to get possession of all properties of the Swatantra Party.
