My dear Raju,

As per our personal discussion I believe you have already taken up the task of getting the list of National General Council members who are with us from each State where we have a party unit. This is a very urgent task to which you may do your best to complete in the next few days. I have written to Mr. V.T. You may also kindly send me a list of workers or leaders in Hariyana, Punjab, Rajasthan, Gujarat and U.P. who are in agreement with all our views on the functioning of the Swatantra party so that myself and Mr. Sundaram may also contact them.

My dear Raju,

I hope you received my letter dated 28th September 1974 requesting you to collect details regarding National Council members and the Executive committee members who are still on the side of the Swatantra party. This information is necessary to decide the next step we have to take for filling up the vacancies at the national level and for going through the preliminary steps for calling a National Convention. I hope you have done something in this matter already and that the required information will be available shortly.

I am in correspondence with Mr. V.T. Srinivasan and he has put me in touch with Mr. Sridharamurthy, who seems to be taking active interest in maintaining the integrity of the party in Karnataka. I am doing what I can to make them file a suit and also activate the party unit of Karnataka.

The Hindu of yesterday carried a report that Mr. Girish Munshi made a statement that the Maharashtra Swatantra party will continue to work independently. Please send me a copy of the statement of Mr. Girish Munshi if available.
