My dear Ravi,

Please find out the followings  
when you are at Madras.

(a) whether the Madras people will  
sponsor the National Convention, if they will  
what is the suitable time. As you say November  
may be more suitable than October.

(b) Prior to that there should be a  
careful planning of the Convention and  
what we propose to do at the Convention. A  
few earlier meetings may well be necessary.

(c) If letters to the various Parts of the  
Committee are to be addressed there may be  
some kind of coordinated effort. Perhaps the  
Madras Unit may organise the effort &  
if they find it too much then the  
work may be divided zone-wise.

(d) A programme may be drawn up not only for organisation but also for ensuring elections which may well come in 1975. Whether to participate in elections or not may be determined at the appropriate stage.

(e) Please find out whether the ~~last~~ copy of our Plans may be sent to the Madras + Mysore Unit and if to whom. I wonder whether it can be handed over to you before you go. Kindly telephone to Sri Dharmadas Malvi of Messrs Eastley Lam to (253034) whether a copy would be ready by the evening for you to carry with you. Please telephone early. It should be understood that this is a draft which should ~~most~~ <sup>first</sup> be final but will require chiselling. This draft will give a rough idea as to the basis on which we wish to proceed.
