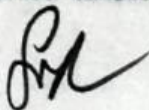
My dear Sreenivasan,

This refers to your letter of August 24 to Mr. Masani who is presently abroad and will be back by the middle of next month.

Something on the lines that you have suggested is already being done in the Civil Court in Madras. Maharashtra is also considering a possibility of following suit. The Constitutional position as stated by you is correct. As we still have ideologically-committed persons in Bangalore who have the time and who can find the resources to go to Court in Bangalore, I shall be glad to send a copy of the plaint so that such person or persons can pursue the matter in the Bangalore Civil Court. It is better to start from a Civil Court. This is the advice of the lawyers both in Maharashtra and Tamilnad.

Incidentally, may I take this opportunity to congratulate you on your correct assessment of Ganapariash, Ghorpade and Co.
