Delegates' Quota and Delegates' Fees

Delegates' Quota

The quota of delegates is based on the enrolment figure in your State/Region as on June 30, 1971.

The ratio of representation is one delegate for every 10 Workers/Life Workers subject to a maximum of 200 delegates.

Your membership as on 30th June, 1971 stands at ----- . You are therefore entitled to a quota of ----- delegates.

Associate Delegates

In order to enable States who wish to send larger contingents to do so, it was decided to have a new category of Associate delegates.

In respect of States where enrolment figures are not available, the minimum quota allotted to any organised State will be the quota of such States. Thus, Assam, Bihar, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal and the Union Territories have been each allotted to ³²----- delegates (which is the minimum delegates' quota of Maharashtra.) Such States are however free to bring as many as ----- Associate Delegates.

We give on the following page the number of delegates and associate delegates Statewise.

Delegates will have full participation rights. Associate delegates may, if allowed by the President, be allowed to speak but not the right to vote.

Delegates' Fees

Each Delegate and Associate Delegate will have to pay a fee of Rs 10/- which will be collected by the National Headquarters Camp Office in -----, on the eve of the Convention.
