Dear Sri. Agni Bhoj.

Thank you for your letter of October 3. Your previous letter has been acted upon though I did not write to you myself. All that you have written is quite true. We cannot however settle the flag in a hurry before there is an All India meeting of our ~~own~~ leading members. It is better we think about the matter and have our own alternative proposals so that we may decide upon the flag to be adopted at that meeting. There is much reason in what you say about the national colours; but we have to consider whether two wrongs make one right. We have also to consider the effect of confusion even in our own ranks. Meanwhile we may have for our purposes a green flag with the word "Swatantra" in local language stitched in white or yellow on the green cloth. This may serve as a temporary flag.

Other points as to subscription may be considered when we meet. Meanwhile you may follow the present procedure taking care that our workers are not tempted to collect Re.1/- and account for eight annas.

My best regards to you. If you and other young colleagues work hard and with full hope and vigour my health will continue to be good.

Please report whether Sri. Zamindar's complaints have been attended to and he is co-operating. I get contradictory reports about this.
