Thanks for your letter of the 21st September. It was a job going through it with its faint and closely typed script!

The Manifesto which will shortly be issued by the Party will clarify its position with regard to the political and economic issues of the day, and will answer some of the doubts you may be entertaining. In the meantime, I would like to tell you that I am not in agreement with what you have tentatively suggested about the basis on which the profits of an undertaking should be divided. If and when I meet you, I shall explain to you the position as I see it.

On another point you have made, I would say that the Swatantra Party holds certain principles which should make it impossible for it to come to terms with the ruling Party in the foreseeable future.

You have reminded me about sending you a copy of the "article" I have contributed to the Symposium on the P.M.. I am now given to understand that I am not at liberty to circulate it to anyone until the volume is published. In the circumstances, I regret I am not in a position to fall in with your wishes.

The work of organising the Regional Committees and enrolling members is going ahead all over the country, and I think we have got off to a good start.
