My dear Krishnaswamy,

This has reference to your letter of the 13th September. I note the revised allocations to the various provincial organizations. The question is how the money is to be found. So far, I have been meeting the calls made on me - this week I have sent Rs.2,500/- to Andhra and Rs.2,500/- to U.P. at your suggestion - but the Treasurer's chest in Bombay is not in too prosperous a condition.

In accordance with the decisions we reached when we met in Bombay towards the end of August, out of the allocation of Rs.1,80,000/- for the various regions, Bombay was to contribute Rs.1 lakh and the balance was to be found from central funds collected in other parts of India. Will you kindly let me know how much has been collected on this account in other States in India and how much of that has been disbursed through your agency?

I would once again suggest that all applications for help should be routed through you so long as the Central Party organization is located in your part of the country, and you might issue instructions accordingly to all the regional organizations. You should also impress upon them the necessity of raising subscriptions locally to meet at least a part of their monthly expenditure.
