My dear Rajaji,

I have received both your letters of September 1 and 2, after I returned from Mussoorie where I had been for a few days' rest.

Prof. Ranga went to Bhopal and had already contacted Shri. Zamindar. I am forwarding your letters to him.

Raja of Ramgarh and Shri Paliwal both are awaiting your instructions to declare the formation of the Swatantra Party in their respective Legislatures. I think they have sufficient number and it would have a great moral effect on the country. Perhaps you may write to them about it.

I think it is time that the treasurer released at least Rs.500/- a month for each of the offices of Rajasthan, Punjab, Delhi, U.P. and Bihar. Work could be expedited if this thing is done promptly. Every one's complaint is that practically there is no central office in Madras. Something requires to be done about it as expeditiously as possible.
