Copy of letter from Shri Raghavendra Pratap Singh,
M.L.A., Uttar Pradesh, dated 2-9-59 to Sri S.Y.
Krishnaswamy, 5, East Circular Road, Madras - 28.

I am thankful to you for your kind letter, dated
25-8-59, addressed to Ch. Laik Singh, you will be
glad to learn that the conference was a big success.
There were about 600 delegates from different districts
of the State. Out of 52 districts, 50 were repre-
sented.

I have to request you for a little clarification
about the amount, you have mentioned, regarding the
monthly expenditure for our regional office. I hope
the Central Office will be good enough to contribute
this Rs. 1,000/- p.m. from their end. The local
contribution is very shy, at present. I do not hope,
that for some time to come, we shall be able to meet
all our expenses, if we have to do the work properly.
We have somehow managed to meet the expenses, incurred
in connection with the convention. We have a hard
task before us, at present, and in the beginning the
expenditure is bound to be high. I am confident you
will be able to arrange the above amount from your
office to us, and make it clear to me.
