My dear Sirdar Sodhbans,

Please refer to your letters of the 21st and 30th July.

I am sorry I did not realize you were waiting for my comments on your letter before making up your mind to come to Bombay for attending the Convention of the Swatantra Party. I was busy with a lot of things and my correspondence got into arrears.

I agree with a great deal of what has been said in the communication addressed by the Delhi Chamber of Commerce to the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry.
