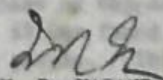
My dear Raju,

I shall be grateful if you will kindly have the following sentences inserted at the end of para 2 on page 2 after the words "Assembly Elections in May 1968" :

"It is a matter for satisfaction that the General Council of the Party at its meeting in Madras in June has ordered an inquiry into the various aspects of the handling of the Dausa by-election which has done so much harm to the Party. The report of the Committee of Inquiry, which is at present investigating the matter will be keenly awaited. Such an inquiry is of high value because it shows what goes wrong and helps the Party to prevent a repetition of the same mistake."

In the next para, delete the words "All this" and substitute: "The state of affairs described above".
