Dear Sir Homi Modi,

On return from Bombay I went to Bangalore to settle the administrative details in respect of the Central Office of the Party. Myself, V.P. Menon, Mr. Narayana Reddi and Sarangapani Mudaliar discussed the details both in respect of organisation and financial arrangements. We came to the conclusion that till a final decision is taken at the All India Convention and the Constitution of the Party ratified, we have to carry on as best we can on a temporary basis without unnecessarily disturbing the status-quo. The Bank authorities state that without a Constitution and rules framed thereunder, they cannot open an account in the name of the Party. Nor in the present circumstances does it appear necessary to have the central account only in one place. Here also the status-quo may continue. Hence the various decisions which are mentioned in the accompanying note that I am sending you for your perusal. You will see from the note that this is only in the nature of tentative proposals which have to be ratified by the organising committee on the 22nd at Bombay.

The following Committees will meet at Bombay:

- i. Committee on Manifesto
- ii. Committee for organisation and Membership
- iii. Constitution committee.

As Treasurer you are ex-officio Member of all of them and I request you to attend them on the 22nd and 23rd. Your presence is important in all the meetings, but especially so in the Committee dealing with Organisation Membership and Finance. I am sending you copies of the invitations sent for the various Committees.
