Dear Mrs. Lynn,

On going through the draft minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 2nd August 1959 I find the following:-

"In respect of donations, attention should be paid to the wishes of each donor, but as a general rule, roughly 50% of the funds collected in Bombay would be allocated to the Centre".

My impression is that there was no definite decision taken by the Committee to allocate roughly 50% of the funds collected in Bombay to the Centre. The Chairman Mr. Masani made a passing observation about this question of collection of funds. However, since no definite decision was taken by the Committee on this matter, I feel that it should not form part of the minutes of the meeting. Moreover, if any decision is to be taken in this matter, I would like the question to be discussed in detail at a meeting when Mr. Masani, Mr. A.D. Shroff and Sir H.P. Mody are all present.

I have, therefore, to request you to kindly put my letter before the next meeting of the Committee with a view to delete this observation from the minutes with the consent of members since no decision has been taken by the Committee on this question. The form in which it has been put in the minutes suggests that this was the official decision of the Committee.

Dear Mrs. Lynn,

Kindly put this letter on the Agenda of our next Committee Meeting for discussion and if possible, circulate it in advance to the members of the Committee so that they may be in a position to apply their minds to the points raised with a view to improve upon suggestions.

2. The Committee now consists of about 24 members and it is very essential that their services are utilized to the best possible advantage to the Party.
3. It is suggested that the entire Committee be sub-divided for the above purpose into four sub-committees with six members each, as under:-
 - (a) Sub-committee for Enrolment of Members and carry out an intensive membership drive;
 - (b) Sub-committee for arranging lectures, meetings, propaganda, discussion groups, seminars, etc. in different wards of Bombay;
 - (c) Sub-committee for collection of funds and arrangement of Programmes, Advertisements, etc. with a view to improve finances; and
 - (d) Sub-committee for newspaper publicity and propaganda.
4. (a) (b) & (c) above should have as their Convenor one of the Joint Honorary Secretaries who would be responsible to the main Committee for the work and activities of his or her sub-committee.

The Honorary Treasurer should be the Convenor of (d).

5. Each Sub-Committee must have its own programme and targets fixed for the next quarter which may be generally approved by the main Committee.
6. There should be weekly informal meetings of the office-bearers with a view to co-ordinate the work of all sub-committees.
7. The Sub-Committees may be permitted to enlist the help of other members of the ^{Party} parties, volunteers and sympathisers as and when found necessary.
8. Each Convenor should present a written report of the activities and achievements of his Sub-Committee to the main Committee once every quarter.

Monthly News Letter: With a view to collect funds from business houses, the Committee may decide to publish a Monthly News Letter with not more than four printed pages of text matter giving news about the Party. The news letter will be distributed free of charge to selected readers. The news letter will contain advertisements at the rate of Rs. 500/- per page per month i.e. Rs. 6,000/- per year for a full-page advertisement from each of
