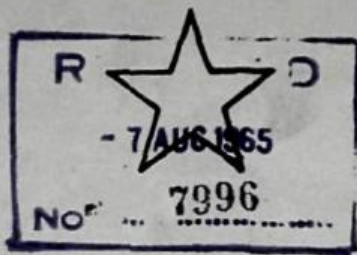

My dear Mr. Masani,

I have not so far received the fresh motion of No-Confidence about which I wrote to you in reply to your telegram and Mr. Dandekar's letter on the subject. As detailed in my earlier letter, our Motion should be submitted to the Lok Sabha the very day the first day's business list is circulated. Then alone we can get priority, otherwise there might be several motions of No-Confidence. Will you, therefore, kindly send the Motion in question to me immediately so that to enable me to ensure priority of our Motion over other parties' Motions.

Mr. Narasimha Reddy our Chief Whip is not in Delhi. Hence, I need your permission to issue a Whip to our Members to be present in the Lok Sabha on the 16th morning when Motions of No-Confidence are likely to be put to the vote of the House. We have to decide the date of our party's meeting also to work ~~on~~ our strategy on the various subjects of national importance which are likely to come up before the House, specially the Kutch agreement which has been opposed by the Jana Sangh, SSP, PSP and the Independent group led by Prakash Vir Shastri. Professor Ranga is reaching Delhi on the 12th in connection with the meeting of the Kerala Advisory Committee. I shall discuss this question with him also.

We have to fix a date for the election of our Parliamentary group office bearers. Last time, we had it in the beginning of September, and our members hold office for one year.
