Dear Minoo

Thank you for your letter of 30th July, which was received today, about a visit to England of your two Members of Parliament - Deo and Singh.

I received, in fact, a telephone call from them on Thursday, 29th July, and gave them lunch on Friday, 30th.

I gather they had been to France and Germany, (where Hans Reif gave them lunch) and were going on to Canada, America, Philippines and Japan. I have, therefore, written to Sauvé (Canada); Zeisler (New York); Montemayor (Manila); and Sato (Japan), to advise them of your colleagues' visit. As I had not then received your letter, I have mentioned that they are Swatantra Party Members of the Indian Parliament and were on a semi-world tour to seek Liberal views and influences.

As I dictated these letters while they were in the office, I did not know, until I received their cards later, of their exact titles. I, therefore, sent a subsequent letter to each of the addressees mentioned above, to tell them of the titles - that I think, will meet the social angle.

I hope that this action - which I had to take "blind" - meets with your approval.

It was not possible for them to meet Richard Moore, as he is now on holiday in France.
