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My dear Arnold:

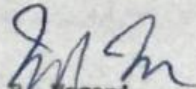
Two members of our Party in Parliament, H.H. Maharaja P.K. Deo of Kalahandi and Mr. Y.N. Singh, members of the Lok Sabha from Orissa, are at present on a world tour. Since they have asked for an introduction to some liberal quarters in New York, I can think of no one else whom I can trouble more appropriately than yourself. I shall be glad if you will kindly contact them and have a chat with them.

I feel that I should say a word of caution. They are not by any means the most outstanding of our spokesmen in Parliament and I think therefore it would not be helpful if you were to project them in New York as representatives of the Party.
