My dear Shri Mohida.

The Parliamentary Board discussed your letters at my instance and resolved that I should have a conference with you to settle these unfortunate differences that have arisen between you and the Gujarat leadership.

If you and he manage to meet each other anytime between now and the 1st August and thresh out matters, it will be so much the better.

I learn that he has sent his Secretary and/or someone who has been once your colleague to meet you and ascertain when it would be convenient for you to meet him but you could not indicate any firm date and place for such a meeting. Do please try to cooperate, meet him and thus make my task easier. I request you to do your best to improve the position of our Swatantra movement and Party in Gujarat and Parliament.
