Dear Mr. Swarup:

In accordance with the Resolution of the Ninth APACL Conference in Saigon, the China Chapter of the Asian Peoples' Anti-Communist League has the honor to inform you that the Tenth APACL Conference has been scheduled to take place from November 23 through 27, 1964 in Taipei. It will be followed by a three-day visiting program.

The main topics to be discussed at the Conference which have been agreed upon by all members of the Executive Committee of the APACL Council beforehand through correspondence, are as follows:

1. How to adopt effective measures to deter Communist aggressive expansion in Southeast Asia?
2. How to take advantage of the Moscow-Peiping rift to intensify our struggle against the international Communists?
3. How to stop the Communist trade offensive against the free world and how to carry out strictly the embargo against the Chinese Communist regime?
4. How to consolidate the free nations in Asia and Africa in order to strengthen their anti-Communist cooperation?
5. How to give concrete support to captive nations and peoples in their struggle for national independence and freedom?

Four Committee will be set up under the Conference. They are:

- (1) Committee on problems of Southeast Asia and elsewhere in Asia;
- (2) Committee on problems of the Middle East and Africa;
- (3) Committee on general problems of the free world; and
- (4) Committee on the drafting of Resolutions and Declaration

The size of the Delegation from each APACL member-unit is not more than 5 delegates and 2 aides. Their boarding, lodging and local transportation during the Conference and visiting period will be taken care of by this Chapter. For each Delegation, this Chapter will offer a round-trip air ticket (tourist class).

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According to the stipulation of the League Charter, the English and French languages will be the two working languages at the Conference. The report at the Conference by the chief delegate from each of APACL member-units should not be longer than 10 minutes. It should be in written form in the above-mentioned two languages and be sent to the China Chapter not later than November the tenth, 1964, so that there would be enough time to make duplicate copies for distribution at the Conference. If the Report should be only in one language, it is hoped that it can be sent to us before the end of October, 1964, and we shall have the other language prepared for the Conference.

We welcome a strong delegation to be sent to the Conference by your Chapter, and we hope that your Delegation will manage to come to Taipei one or two days before the Conference begins. Meanwhile, please send us before the end of October, 1964, the names, photos, personal data and addresses of all members of your Delegation. Also, please advise us if we can be of assistance to your Delegation in matters concerning the application of visa.

We deem it a great honor to have the Tenth APACL Conference be held in Taipei, and we earnestly hope that the forthcoming Taipei Conference will be a great success with the kind cooperation of your Chapter.
