My dear Dahyabhai,

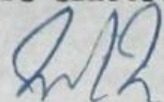
Thank you for your letter of August 20.

I am afraid I can reach Delhi from Calcutta only on the morning of Sunday, September 6 in time for our meetings that day.

In so far as the motion of no-confidence is concerned, the meeting of the Parliamentary Board is being called primarily to give us guidance on that point and we should not make commitments to anyone that we shall participate in any such motion as the whole issue is wide open for discussion. Several of our people are against our joining in such a move altogether.

I am working on the minutes of the dissent to the Gold Control Bill and will send you a draft as soon as I can for your information and comments.
