Sir,

I am greatly perturbed by the attitude of S. Kapur Singh, the Secretary of our Parliamentary Group towards our Party. While taking part in the obituary references to the late lamented Prime Minister on the 29th of May on the floor of the House surprisingly enough he expressed his condolences on behalf of the Akali Party in Parliament. There is no Akali Party in Parliament. They have joined the Swatantra Party in Parliament. If a plea be taken that they were elected to the Lok Sabha with a different symbol, tomorrow the Members elected on the symbol of bow and arrow of Ganatantra Party and on cycle of Janata Party, will also claim to take a similar stand which will ultimately dis-integrate the Swatantra Party in Parliament. Such attitude of any member of the Parliamentary Party and more so of its Office bearers should be discouraged.

From the office records, I find that Sardar Kapur Singh is in arrears of Rs.140/-, which is equivalent to Rs.480/- on account of Party contribution. Further, there is strong feeling why Sardar Kapur Singh should pay Rs.20/- per month whereas others ~~should~~ pay Rs.40/- a month. I think it is high time now that the previous decision has to be reconsidered in view of the strong feeling among the Members. A member of our Party claiming equal privileges should be willing to contribute equally to our Party fund.

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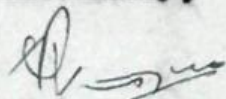
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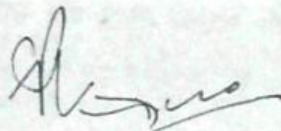
