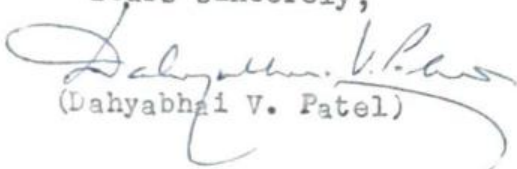

Dear Mr. Masani,

I find that it is difficult to get anything done in the office. Is the office meant only for Members of Lok Sabha or it is for the Members of the Rajya Sabha also. It appears that whenever I tried to get some work done, some Members of the Lok Sabha comes in between and thus my work is always put aside for doing it afterwards. They go on to the extent of doing this in the case of persons like Mr. Parikh, who is not even in the employ of the Office. How is this justified? If Members of the Rajya Sabha are not to get assistance from this office, either separate staff should be employed for their work or they should not be asked for the contribution. The Office seems to be in a poor condition and needs to be straightened up immediately. The Rajya Sabha members hardly get any assistance from this office. Since this morning, I have been trying to get someone to take a sum of Rs.2000/- sent by our Gujarat Member, Shri Hamir Singh Solanki, to be paid as advance for his case before the Supreme Court Advocate, Mr. Sukla. The Gujarat Party Leader has asked me to pay the full sum of Rs.2000/-; that he has not yet paid me that sum. I have agreed to do so. But since I have not been able to find any one responsible to come and take the money, the same could not be deposited. Mr. Jain is busy with the office work or attending Mr. Ranga's work. What a wonderful condition?
