Dear Sir,

I have received the papers regarding the Indian Pavilion in the New York World Fair which you have sent to me for drafting some questions. Necessary action as desired by you is being taken in the matter.

I sent you four questions regarding certain grievances of Central Government Employees posted in Gujarat, the material for which you had sent to me earlier. I have no idea whether you have sent those questions after your signature to Lok Sabha Secretariat directly or not. I was anxious to find out the fate of the questions as I had not indicated the dates for answer.

I am enclosing herewith for your perusal a brief letter to the editor against the Constitution (17th) Amendment Bill which has been published in Hindustan Times of 5th August. This letter has coincided with our COC Resolution at Madras against the Bill in question.
