Dear Sir,

As desired, I have drafted four questions on the subject of various grievances of Central Government servants, posted in Gujrat. It is not possible to cover all details in one question as that way it will become too long and will not be admissible under the Rules. I have framed two questions concerning part(a) so that to see at least one of them is admitted, and one each about the other two parts. Dates etc. for increase in D.A. by Maharashtra and Gujrat, as mentioned in the draft, cannot be put in the questions as that way these will become suggestive and consequently inadmissible under the rules. These and similar other details can be thrashed out in the Supplementaries.

I have not indicated the date for answer. Kindly sign and send the same to me so that to enable me to submit them to proper quarters after filling in the date. Minimum 10 days notice has to be given under the rules.
