Q U E S T I O N

- a) What steps have been taken by Central Government to enforce upon the Gujarat Government to implement decisions of 2nd Pay Commission's report and whether any assurance has been given by the Gujarat State to finalise this question and whether the idea of ~~any~~ Central Government is taking effective steps to settle the matter with Gujarat State within stipulated period.
- (b) Whether the Central Government has taken effective steps to remove disparity in payment of dearness allowance where the Central Pay Commission's recommendations have not been implemented.
- (c) The Central Government servants working in Gujarat before the mixing of their D.A. in pay were getting much dearness allowance than the Gujarat state servants. Maharashtra State increased dearness allowance of Rs.10/- for 1-5-1960 but Gujarat State instead of 1-5-60 gave increase from 1-10-1961, i.e. after 17 months. Whether the Central Government has taken steps to know reasons from Gujarat State for this dispartive treatment to two states formed from new reorganised State of Bombay. Whether the Central Government is contemplating to remove the disparity of dearness allowance in Gujarat State when facts stand that Gujarat State claims central assistance in payment of dearness allowance in some cases.
