Dear Sir,

I am enclosing herewith a letter addressed to the Secretary, Lok Sabha, for moving a resolution which may please be signed and returned to this office for submission to the Lok Sabha Secretariat.

The procedure for tabling the resolutions has now changed. Previously the Members were required to submit the text of resolutions proposed to be moved but under the new procedure, the Members have simply to give their names to show their intention for moving the resolutions in the coming Session of the Lok Sabha. Only the names are balloted and if your name comes up in the ballot you may then move any resolution you feel like with the permission of the Speaker.

As desired by Prof. Ranga, we want to raise in the Parliament the recent Patnaik-Mehtab controversy. This can only be done by way of a resolution when we may take up the question of corruption in high offices and in detail what is happening in the Centre and the State of Orissa. There are a number of other important subjects also which we have to thrash out in the Parliament.
