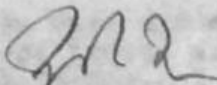

My dear Jain,

I have your letter No. SPPO/280/4/63 dated 15th June, and am glad that you have drawn my attention to the developments regarding to the India-China frontier.

In so far as such matters as a motion of no-confidence is concerned, this is nothing that either I or anyone else can take a decision on. The Central Organising Committee or Parliamentary Board is alone competent to decide these matters. These Committees are being called early in August to consider these problems. I would, therefore, suggest you to make no move whatsoever in this matter. The tabling of questions of course, is another matter, which each individual member can decide for himself.
