Dear Sir,

I have received a letter from Prof Ranga in which he has suggested that we should, if we can muster enough support, press for a no-confidence motion against the whole Government in the coming session of the Parliament. For this purpose we can convene a meeting of all the democratic opposition groups, as we have already done twice, a day or two before the start of August Session. Kindly indicate the date convenient to you so that letters might be sent to such of the Members as you think advisable. Previously we invited but for the Communists all the leaders of the opposition groups, including Shri Karni Singh, Mr Frank Anthony and Shri Prakashvir Shastri from the independents.

We have also to convene a meeting of our Parliamentary Group for the election of office bearers. Your advice is solicited as to when should be have such a meeting.

For the August session of Parliament I am preparing briefs on the following subjects:

- a) Shortfalls in the Third Plan
- b) Against nationalisation of Banks
- c) Constitution (17th Amendment) Bill (Amendment of Art 31)

Kindly advise me as to what other subjects you would like me to study.

I have already given notice of some 150 questions in the name of our Members.

Synopsis of speeches of our Members during the last session are being prepared. As before, copies will be cyclostyled and circulated to all our Members, members of the Parliamentary Board and General Council and the State Units.
