My dear Raju,

I met our President, Mr.G.K.Sundaram, last evening. He told me about the talk he had with you sometime back and that you again put forth the idea of having CHANAKYAN published as a Bi-lingual magazine having two pages in English and the rest in Tamil. Of course we too had a talk about this and there was exchange of letters also. I have again discussed this matter with Mr.J.Ramabhadran. He is willing to have two pages of party matters in English and the rest in Tamil. He wants our cooperation and assistance in the following matters:

1. Party news and connected matter for publication in English be supplied by our Bombay office.
2. List of subscribers in other States who require this bi-lingual CHANAKYAN be furnished by the party offices, which are interested in this matter.
3. Usual subscription be remitted either by subscribers in advance or the party units may collect and remit the subscription in advance, so that copies may be posted by Mr.Ramabhadran directly to subscribers at the concessional rate of postage.
4. The extra cost of printing 2 pages of English matter will be made good by providing advertisement at a cost of Rs.150/- per issue per page.

Mr.Sundaram has agreed to make good the cost of printing two pages of additional matter in English. The actual ~~cost~~ amount involved was not mentioned to him for want of information at that time. I am writing to him a separate letter giving details.

I am sending a copy of this letter to Mr.Munshi.
