Dear Bhamubabu,

Many thanks for your letter of 26th June 1976 along with the enclosures which I showed to Mr. Masani and also to members of the Swatantra Party's National Executive when it met in Bombay on June 29th. I enclose here-
with the text of the resolutions adopted by the meeting.

I am also enclosing an article I wrote for the July issue of Freedom First commenting on the draft policy statement circulated by Mr. Goray's Committee.

I have in this connection gone through the draft policy statement prepared by your party. Both Mr. Masani and I are substantially in agreement with it though we continue to have reservations about artificial restrictions re: large scale, small scale industries. You might perhaps recall that around November 1968 at the meeting of the National Executive of the Swatantra Party where Mr. Prakash Vir Sastri was present as the BKD representative, Rajaji was unable to accept a position regarding reservation of certain industries exclusively for the small scale sector or vice-versa. But by and large the proposed draft policy statement of the Janata Party is basically Swatantra in tone - not surprising with you as the General Secretary of the BLD !

Incidentally would you have an idea of where various persons who are in Jails are held? We might be able to post them reading material. *of a general nature.*
Do let us keep in touch.
