He is anxious to know your views on the minimum programme that will be acceptable to us for joint functioning with Congress (C), Jan Sangh and socialists and also find out whether we should immediately take steps to join the federal type of grouping of democratic opposition parties excluding Congress (R) and Communists. Actually this suggestion was made by us officially in June 1974 and unofficially to Mr. Modi as early as January 1974. Since the other parties especially Jan Sangh and the Socialists have now come round to our view, we have to take a decision at the official level of the party. Our President will like to discuss these matters with the three of you who are on the National Executive. Hence please do meet him and let me know the result of the discussions and let me know.
