Your letter dated 30th March reached me only on 3rd instant perhaps after you had returned to Bombay from Hyderabad. Hence I could not write to Mr.S.V.Pantulu and I hope you were able to contact Mr.Pantulu.

I have noted your remarks regarding the meeting of the National Executive and the Central Parliamentary Board. Of course you have a very valid point in suggesting more meetings of the Central Board than that of National Executive. But we have informally taken a decision at the last meeting at Bombay to call the next meeting of the National Executive before the end of March at Madras and Mr. Girish Munshi had been writing to us in this matter. Of course there are certain important subjects to be discussed and decided subject of course to the approval of the National General Council, National Executive being a mere representative organ of the party. These meetings once in three months at least will help to publicise our point of view on several important subjects that may be agitating the public mind.

Regarding provisions of funds to the Karnataka unit, I realise that the efforts made by our esteemed Sri Masani have ~~made~~ produced only negative results.
