giving representation to all the districts wherever
we have workers carrying on party activities. It is
also preferable that the person/s visiting U.P. will
have to hold one or two Press Conferences at key
centres and explain the present party position so
that the people of U.P. will know that the Party
not only continues to exist but is also active.
