Dear Shri. Masani,

While welcoming you to Madras for the forthcoming General Council meeting which is to be held next month, I am to inform you about what ~~Revered~~ Rajaji has instructed me to communicate to you about what Dr. H.V. Hande, the General Secretary of the Tamil Nadu Swatantra Party writes in a Tamil journal 'Chanakyan' edited by one Mr. Ramabhadran, who is also a member of the General Council. The tenor of Dr. Hande's writings is in the way of attacking our party's views on Privy Purse, Land Ceiling and labour. The Madras District Swatantra Party and true lovers of the principles of our party have taken a serious note of the views as published in that journal. The full text of Dr. Hande's writings in the journal will be available with Mr. S.V. Raju, Secretary, A.I.S.P., which you may kindly peruse to form your own opinion about them. My own belief is that only the policies of our party can bring about the well being of our nation. But what Dr. Hande writes will lead one to the conclusion that our party is a rich man's party. I was most anxious to bring this to your notice. Rev. Rajaji to whom I mentioned about my desire to you, Mr. Piloo Mody and Mr. Madhu Mehta he appreciated my interest and was agreeable to my writing to you and getting your views. My main point is that the fact that there is no shift in the policy of our party should be emphasised by leaders of of your standing to remove the wrong impressions that may be created by reading the writings of Dr. Hande. Please give your serious consideration to this vital matter concerning our party's policies and give clarifications which you think necessary to counter the views as expressed by Dr. Hande. Your clarifications

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may also be published in the same journal - Chanakyan.
