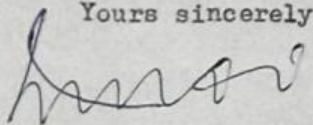
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My dear Naoroz,

- * As arranged, I forward herewith the draft petition in regard to the Government Monopoly of Broadcasting and
- * a file, No.102.A. Soli and I both feel that it is high time that we proceeded with finalising the petition while awaiting a reply from Mr.Arjun Singh. It is true that you will not be able to settle paragraphs 4 & 5 of the draft petition because they deal with the correspondence between ourselves and Government which has yet to conclude. But Soli and I feel that the rest of the petition can now be revised and sent back to Soli for settling and keeping ready.

- * If I may make a suggestion, I wonder whether the attached study of the News in English made by the Indian Committee for Cultural Freedom and the Indian Liberal Group, which has been produced after the petition was drafted, can be added as an appendix to the petition.
