26/27th Feb. 1966: CPB meeting in Madras turned down C.C.Desai's nomination for the Rajya Sabha and nominated Dr. Beharilal Anantani.

Letters of protest from B.D.Patel, Baria and MRM's and Rajaji's reply in File No. C/22.

May 20, 1966 : MRM's confidential letter to Rajaji (attached)

27/28-5-1966 : G.C. meeting in Bombay has long discussion on G.S. Report on Organisation since February 1965 and on decisions of CPB in regard to three-man committees and field organisers. (H.M.Patel's plea for complete independence for the Gujarat Party and M.R.M.'s reply while winding up the discussion)

Agreement re Collections

19-7-1966 : Agreement between M.R.M. and H.M.Patel re. collection of funds in Bombay:

"Mr Patel expressed a desire on the part of the Gujarat unit to raise funds to supplement the Central funds and the Gen. Secretary welcomed this move. Mr. Patel felt that the list of parties in Bombay and elsewhere outside Gujarat whom the Gujarat Unit had agreed not to approach, as they were contributing to the Central Party funds, was too long and requested that it might be cut down somewhat. The General Secretary agreed to do this. A shortened and revised list has now been made available to the Gen. Secretary of the State unit and to Mr. H.M.Patel, and they have reiterated their agreement not to approach any of these parties for financial support to the State unit. Mr. Patel has, however, urged that, from the month of October 1966 onwards, the Gujarat unit should be permitted to approach those on the list of Central donors who originate from Gujarat with a view to getting supplementary assistance and has given the assurance that this would be done in such a way that would not prejudice the commitments made to the

Centre by these parties and would not involve the possibility of any diversion of such funds from the Centre. The General Secretary has agreed to this request."
