I am sure these jeeps which were formally registered in Raju's and my name when he was Executive Secretary and I was the Party's President, must have been sold soon after the 1971 elections.

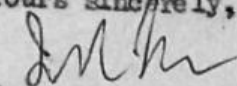
In order to enable us to reply to the R.T.O. will you kindly let me have the following particulars in respect of the above jeeps:-

4. Incidentally you might as well also let me know whether the Bombay Municipal Corporation has been informed of their sale. If so, kindly let me have copies of the letters concerned. This will enable us to deal with them if they in turn raise any queries about wheel tax at a later date.

In view of the fact that the R.T.O. expect a reply within seven days I shall appreciate it if you will kindly give this your urgent attention.

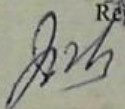
