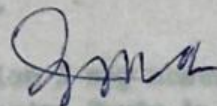

My dear Bhatia,

I am glad to inform you that as a result of the letters I wrote to the R.T.O., etc., I have now been informed by the Regional Transport Officer that the Collector of Bombay has been asked to drop the proceedings in respect of the jeeps Nos. MRA 4095, MRA 4096, MRA 4092 and MRA 4024, that we had discussed.
