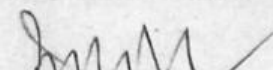

Dear Mr. Sinha,

Since I wrote to you last on 24th March, I have received a letter from Mr. V.P. Bhatia of the Bharatiya Lok Dal (photocopy attached) which speaks for itself. This has been corroborated to me a couple of days back by Mrs. Vina Modi, widow of the late Mr. Pilloo Mody, M.P. whom I met confirming that the jeep was with them for several years.
