Dear Shri Masani,

I invite your attention to your letter dated the 23rd February, 1987 as regards the payment of arrears of motor vehicles tax in respect of car No. MRG 2347. It has been reported to me that the records of the Regional Transport Officer show that the car is registered in your name. While I note your clarification that the car belonged to the Swatantra Party, in view of its registration in your name, the tax liability obviously devolves on you. In case, however, the car has been transferred to some-one else, if you would be kind enough to furnish the details, it will be possible to examine whether the arrears of motor vehicles tax in question can be recovered from the transferee. I look forward to receiving these details within a few days.

I wish to assure you that there is no intention to harass you in this matter. Had the transfer of the car been properly notified to the Regional Transport Officer, such inconvenience as has been caused to you in the recovery proceedings would have been avoided. Things can be set right provided details of the transfer are made available. I seek your co-operation in the matter.
