Some points for letter to Mr. Sinha, Collector of Customs.

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All the jeeps that were used in the 1967 elections were sold by the Swatantra Party to various companies and individuals including A.C.C., Maharani Gayatri Devi of Jaipur etc. This was reported by us to the R.T.O. as far back as July 2, 1971 (?) and sent by Registered A.D.

Having ceased to be an office bearer of the party in April 1971 and not being in possession of the files of the Party, it is not possible for me now to say to whom each jeep was sold. In the letter under reference I had advised the traffic authorities to approach the offices of the Bharatiya Lok Dal, 143 Mahatma Gandhi Road who were then in possession of the records.

With the winding up of the B.L Dal there is no trace of the Party's files. You will therefore appreciate the fact that this vehicle never belonged to me and was sold to the Swatantra Party soon after the elections of 1967 which was mentioned to the transport authorities as far back as \_\_\_\_\_ copy of which is attached ~~to~~ I am unable to furnish any other details.

I have been doing my best to try and co-operate with the R.T.O. ~~and~~ in trying to track down the persons to whom the jeeps were sold. (e.g.) Copy of letter dated March 20, 1975.
